Third Generation Vintner, Jim Concannon, helped change the landscape of California wine history with his 1964 introduction of “America’s First Petite Sirah” from his 1961 vintage. Before that time, Petite Sirah was used only as a blending grape in winemaking; however, Jim recognized this luscious variety’s wonderful potential as a varietal wine. Jim is now affectionately known as the “Father of Petite Sirah.”

Our Heritage Petite Sirah is grown on our estate in the vineyard on the right when you drive through the gates. This full-bodied wine is released exclusively to our Legacy Club members, made with some of the highest quality grapes that our land has to offer. Our winemaker focused on creating wonderfully complex flavors with smooth tannins in these Heritage Petite Sirahs for you to savor and enjoy.

## 2014 HERITAGE PETITE SIRAH

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### VINEYARD LOCATION:

The grapes that make up this Petite Sirah come from our Block 1 Heritage Vineyard on the right of our winery entrance. This special vineyard has been planned to Petite Sirah since 1883. Last replanted in 2003, the vines are still head trained.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 98% Petite Sirah, 2% Zinfandel

APPELLATION: Livermore Valley

ALCOHOL: 14.5%

CASES PRODUCED: 121

TITRATABLE ACIDITY: 0.68g/100mL

AGING: Aged in French Barriques for 28 months    PH: 3.41

### WINEMAKER NOTES:

Opaquely colored, the 2014 Heritage Petite Sirah is a classic example of the full-bodied, rich varietal. Captivating from the start with aromas of bright candied cherry and spice. Tightly packed on the palate with sweet and expressive notes of red fruit, caramel, and chocolate truffle. Silky tannins compliment a spicy oak finish.

### PAIRING SUGGESTIONS:

Grilled pork loin with raspberry and dried cherry glaze or try Petite Sirah braised wild mushrooms with pasta



## 2015 HERITAGE PETITE SIRAH

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### VINEYARD LOCATION:

The grapes that make up this Petite Sirah come from our Block 1 Heritage Vineyard on the right of our winery entrance. This special vineyard has been planned to Petite Sirah since 1883. Last replanted in 2003, the vines are still head trained.

### WINEMAKER NOTES:

True to the varietal, inky black color permeates the glass while aromas of brown sugar, coffee and blackberry waft effortlessly to the nose. Dense flavors coat the palate, showcasing jammy dark fruit that is packed with richness. Smooth tannins and integrated oak flavors round out this impeccable vintage.

### PAIRING SUGGESTIONS:

Braised Beef Short Ribs with blackberry compote or try grilled garlic portobello mushrooms with turmeric rice
